Abstract Submission Instructions

1. Abstracts must be sent by the announced deadline through Email to the sgrhpcsicu@gmail.com. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered.
2. The same person may submit up to 3 abstracts regardless of presenting author.
3. The same person may serve as presenting author in up to 3 abstracts.
4. Presenting author, whose abstract is accepted, must register for the conference by Feb 15, 2026.
5. Only abstracts of authors who paid their registration fees by Feb 15, 2026 will be scheduled for presentation.
6. The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract and agree to its submission, before submitting the abstract.
7. Abstract will be selected for oral and poster presentations

Abstract Content

1. Title: Provide a concise and informative title, limited to 25 words.
2. Authors: Include the names and affiliations of all authors involved in the study. Indicate the presenting author, and his contact details.
3. Abstract Text (250 words) should contain following —
 1. Research article : Background, Aims, Methods, Results, Conclusion.
 2. Case Report / Case Series: Points / Discussion Background, Case Summary, Learning.
4. Use generic names of drugs.
5. Correspondence: All correspondence will be sent to the presenting author.
